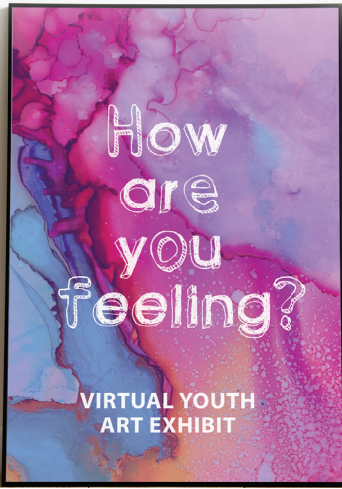


How are you feeling? The youth response to COVID-19

For images:

Please submit a high resolution JPEG file. For those familiar with high resolution files, that's no less than 150 DPI quality. When in doubt, please send the images to us and we will let you know if they are unusable.

A minimum of 2400 pixels (8 in) height or width is preferred.

Examples: 2400 x 1800 px or 8 x 6 in

Take clear, in-focus photos of your artwork. Use a high quality setting on the back-facing camera on your smartphone. Try to avoid "flash marks" or reflections in your photos.

Taking your photo directly from above with a natural light source is sometimes best.

If you have access to a quality scanner, this is a great option.

If you have a DSLR camera for photos, that is even better.

For literary works:

Please submit your work as a pdf or word document.

If you are submitting your handwritten literary work as a photo, please review the guidelines above.

For videos:

Videos that are approximately two minutes or less in length tend to be viewed more completely than longer videos, therefore a max of 2 minutes is preferred.

The easiest ways to share video files are to upload a .mov or .mp4 file onto a file-sharing site (google drive or dropbox for example) and send us the link and details via email.

Please film yourself or your work in a clear, in-focused manner in a well-lit area.

Video resolution must be at least 1080p (1920 x 1080) or 4K (3840 x 2160). Please contact us if you have questions about this. If you have an HD camera/phone/tablet and it's set to shoot video at 1080p that will work.

When using text to show the name and title of an individual or name of the organization, include proper names. Please spell check and avoid spelling errors.

Avoid using copyrighted sounds. Alternatives to using copyrighted sound recordings for background music include: Ambient noise, audio that is shared via a Creative Commons license compositions and recordings by friends who grant you permission, and music you create yourself.
